
## Phillip Island Penguin Parade \$145

- ✓ After our 2 hour journey, the first stop is the wildlife park (included) where you will have the opportunity to view Kangaroos, Koala and many of the other Australian animals.
- ✓ We then visit Cowes the local village on the island. Here you will be able to explore some of the local shops and beach.
- ✓ We then travel to the Nobbies, a rugged rocky outcrop and seal rock. Here you will get the chance to walk along the boardwalk and visit the seal centre.

## Sovereign Hill & Wildlife Park \$175
